To close out the month, NYC deep house and techno vet Anthony Parasole is at the controls from start to finish on June 29, and Fruits and Vegetables return for another fête June 30 with special guest Shaun J. Wright. If you're in the mood to learn a thing or two, Think Olio is dropping by the indoors on June 26 for another mind-expanding class.

PRIDE

We've put together a couple special events for Pride, the first of which is a free backyard barbecue from noon until late on Saturday, June 23rd. We'll have brisket, ribs and fixin's at the barbecue tent, and selectors Lex Rodriguez, Michael Magnan, Olive T, Gooddroid, JT Almon and FBI Warning will be setting the vibe from noon until 2am. That same night, Lauren Flax hosts DJ Heather and Lily Ackerman for a proper party on the big sound system, and then the next day, June 24th, we host a special Pride edition of Mister Sunday with Ciel and DJ Python at the controls. Ten percent of the profits go to the Ali Forney Center, an organization that protects LGBTQ youth from the harms of homelessness and empowers them with the tools needed to live independently.



Nowadays is a big back yard and plant-filled living room bar on the Bushwick/Ridgewood border. There's a reasonably priced food truck out back, seven days a week. We serve excellent drinks (from cocktails to coconut water), and we program fun, fulfilling music and cultural events on select days and nights.

Outdoors, we've got ping pong, film screenings and good tunes. Indoors we host parties and listening sessions on our custom sound system and pop-up dinners in our kitchen. Board games are behind the bar. Kids can run free. Dogs are always welcome outside on a leash.

On June 7th, Prince Rogers Nelson would've turned 60. Prince remains one of the most celebrated musicians in the world even in the afterlife. This month, we're doing two special events, not to mourn Prince's untimely passing but instead to celebrate his life.
