**HAPPY SPRING!** We're getting excited over here. On May 10 the full vision will be realized for the first time: our back yard opens alongside the indoors at Nowadays. We've been busy making sure it's just right – new trees, fresh sod, extra coziness – and we can't wait to open and invite folks in for a meal, a drink and a lounge on the grass.

We're bringing back all the outdoor staples: seven-day-a-week lounging under the sun and stars, Saturday backyard barbecues, carefully selected selectors playing summer jams on Friday and Saturday evenings, a reading series with H.I.P. Lit and, of course, Mister Sunday, our open-air, all-ages, all-walks-of-life dance party that happens every Sunday from 3pm to 9pm. It starts on May 13th.

Indoors remains a force. Sal P, our buddy/vegan chef/lead singer of legendary, LCD-Soundsystem-inspired outfit Liquid Liquid, is taking over our kitchen on May 1, cooking up a meatless, dairyless feast. He'll play some tunes as well.

We'll also host our last Planetarium of the season indoors on May 6. Sound artist and abstract turntablist Maria Chavez joins Eamon, Justin and Josh behind the decks for the night. Grab a pillow and blanket, lie down on the floor and get lost with us one more time before we pack it in for the summer.

On Thursdays indoors, we continue our free party series with local hero CecilB (who's closing her amazing Starvue space at the end of May), Mira Fahrenheit, L&L&L Record Club, Butter, Cam and the A1 Records All Stars. And, oh yeah, the Fania Records crew are doing a night on May 17, with selectors serving jams both indoors and out back.

The first Friday of the month indoors, the skilled DJs of Working Women team up with techno vanguard rRoxymore for a night of far-flung dance tunes, followed in short order by two titanic techno matchups: Hank Jackson and Pangaea on May 5 and Aurora Halal and DJ Richard on May 11. On May 12, DJ Python invites his buddies Beta Librae and Sold (from Chicago's excellent Hugo Ball dance) to the floor.

The third weekend of the month indoors goes to two of the hands-down best jams in the city. Between Allergy Season's Friday lineup (Detroit freeform hero Scott Zacharias and local club whisperers Complete Walkthru and Physical Therapy) and The Bunker LTD's Saturday feature (techno shaman Marco Shuttle), there's a little something for everyone.

On the last weekend of the month indoors, we're hosting Tokyo producer Moko Shibata, aka Powder, for a special all-night set. We'll also do an installment of FNV with special guest False Witness and a Sunday-night all-vinyl jam with DJ Spinna and Sean Rowlands after the Mister Sunday Memorial Day Weekend Special.

To close out the month indoors, it's another kitchen takeover on May 29, this one by Nowadays fam Mantra Lance, who runs Remedi Food (food magick, y'all); and then, on May 30, a Think Olio session with professor and composer Whitney George, who's presenting a deep listening session on the hi-fi.

Whether you join us for backyard beer, a hang under the trees or a dance among the smoke machines, we look forward to seeing you outdoors or indoors soon. It's been a long time coming.

## FRIDAY AND SATURDAY EVENINGS, OUTDOORS

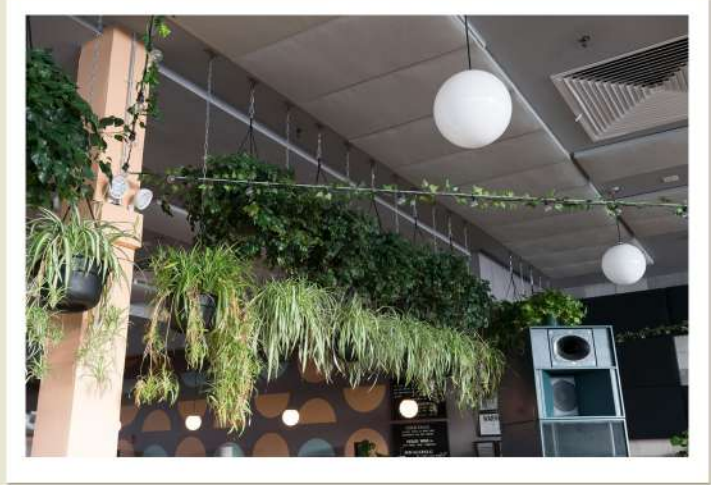

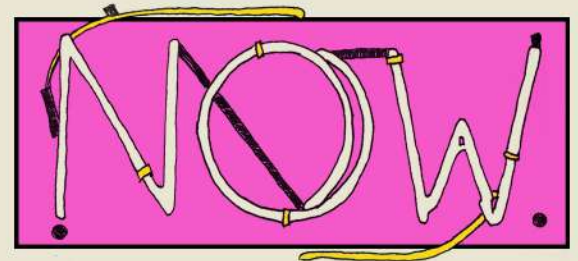
## MISTER SUNDAY, OUTDOORS
